UIU Benefits for Military and Veterans

- Patriot Grant available to all military personnel (active, guard, reserve and retired), as well as their family who are Department of Defense ID card holders. Veterans also qualify for the Patriot Grant.
- Credit for your military service (based on Joint Services Transcript).
- Transfer up to 90 semester credits from an accredited 4-year institution (max. of 78 lower-division credits from a 2-year institution) with C- grade or better.
- Receive \$250 per undergraduate credit hour and \$325 per graduate credit hour through the Military Family Grant for all eligible spouses and dependents of active duty, reserve and National Guard service members.
- Personal UIU advisor available for consultations.
